

Alpha Delta Gamma Foundation Post-Undergraduate Scholarship Application Guidelines

The overall intent of The ADG Foundation Post-Undergraduate Scholarship is to support and encourage the overall development of our post-undergraduate students to be a well-rounded individual and a positive contributor to society. We believe that is best developed through the devotion and living the Fraternity's 5 S's. The Post-Undergraduate Scholarship is intended to support and maintain an Alum's further pursuit of educational opportunities so he can continue to live the 5 S's as an Alum.

1. The following information must be submitted with this application:
 - a. A brief, biographical sketch must be submitted with your application. This sketch should contain personal narrative of your current activities & could be used for marketing content (such as an edition of the Alphadelity). Your current activities portion should be tied to the 5 S's of the Fraternity: Service, Scholastic, Spiritual, Social, and School Spirit. These can be examples from ADG or non-ADG sponsored/related activities. You may use any format, including an outline form. But your submission must not be longer than two, single-spaced pages.
2. **This is a post-undergraduate scholarship.** Applicants must be enrolled as a graduate student at an accredited college or University. ~OR~ They must be enrolled in a trade school, a technical institution or a Police/Fire/EMT academy.
3. The intention of this Scholarship is to support or reduce the education cost born by the Student himself or his parents. Thus, please do not apply if our scholarship support will simply result in a dollar-for-dollar reduction in student aid, other grants/scholarships or workplace financial assistance.
4. Your membership in the Fraternity must be in good standing. The Foundation will independently verify your membership and research that all dues owed (if any) to your undergraduate Chapter and National are paid via confirmation with the undergraduate Chapter and National VP's of Finance, respectively.
5. The scholarship will be made payable to your present school, to be used for tuition, books, or housing, unless otherwise noted in this application.
6. The application and all accompaniments must be received no later than June 15th to be eligible for consideration.
